Existing law establishes, and sets forth the mission of, the California Community Colleges Economic and Workforce Development Program as part of the responsibilities of the California Community Colleges. This bill would encourage the chancellor to authorize the establishment of a Public Sector Customer Service Academy, the purpose of which would be to provide training for state and local public agency employees in key areas of customer service and to equip these workers with skills that can be applied in the workplace. The bill would specify courses that would be offered at the academy. The bill would require the chancellor to undertake a study of the feasibility of establishing a Public Sector Professional Development Institute within the California Community Colleges Economic and Workforce Development Program. The bill would state the intent of the Legislature that the chancellor utilize existing resources to implement these provisions.
